(43) The terms "broker" and "merchant" means a person assisting in organizing an international transaction into a chemical product listed by "a) negotiating contracts; (b) serve as an agent or intermediary; or (c) to bring together a buyer and seller, a buyer and conveyor, or a seller and a transporter. (44) The term "drug offensive crime" means an offense that is punishable with prison for more a year under any United States law or a state or foreign country that proceeds or restricts the conduct related to narcotic drugs, marijuana, steroid anabolizing, or depressive or stimulant substances. (45) The term "Product chemical listed programmed" means, subject to paragraph (b), a product that       (i) contain ephedrine, pseudoefedrine or phenylpropanolamine; and (ii) can be marketed or legally distributed in the United States under federal law, food, drug and cosmetics [21 u.s.c. 301 et seq.] as a medication without prescription. Each reference in the clausula (I) for ephedrine, pseudoephedrine or phenylpropanolamine includes each of the salts, omtpic isyls and salts of omtpomal isteres of that chemistry. (B) such a term does not include a product described in Alterna A), if the product contends a chemical product specified in this paragraph that the Prosecutor General shall have under the section 811 (a) of the present one of the haven in the 512 (c) section of this Title. In the absence of such a programming by the prosecutor a chemical substance specified in this paragraph may be considered as being a controlled substance. (46) The term "regulated seller" means a retail distributor (including a pharmacy or a mobile retail provider), except that such a term does not include an employee or agent of such a dispenser. (47) The term "mobile retail seller" means a person or entity that causes retail sales from a position that is intended to be temporary, or is capable of being moved from One location to another, if the support is located inside or the premises of a fixed installation (such as a kiosk in a mall or an airport) or if the support is located in Unimproved Imobilia (such as a batch or retail field for retail purposes). (48) The "in retail" expression, as regards sale or purchase of a scheduled chemical product, means a sale or purchase for personal use, respectively. (A) The term "retail distributor" means a supermarket, goods shop in general, pharmacia, or other entity or person whose activity as a distributor relating to ephedrine, pseudoephedrine, or phenylpropanolamine products are almost limited Exclusively at sales for personal use, both in the number of sales and sales volume, either directly to Walk-in clients or face-to-face transactions by direct sales. (B) for the purposes of this paragraph, entities are defined by reference to the Industrial Code Patient Classification (SIC), as follows: (i) a grocery store is an entity inside Code SIC 5411. (ii) A general goods storage is an entity inside SIC 5300 codes through 5399 and 5499. (iii) Storing a drug is an entity in the SIC code 5912. (50) The term "Internet" means collectively the Miranty of Informal equipment and telecommunications, including equipment and software in operation, which comprise the global network of interconnected networks employing the Transmission Control Protocol / Internet Protocol, or any predecessor or successor protocol of such protocol, to communicate information of all kinds, by wire or radio. (51) The term "delivering, distributing, or distribution through the Internet" refers, respectively, for any delivery, distribution, or dispensing of a controlled substance, which is caused or facilitated through the Internet. (52) The term "online pharmacia" a (a) means a person, entity or website, whether in the United States or abroad, which conscious or intentionally offers, distributes or dispensing, or offers or delivery attempts, distribute, or distribution, a controlled substance through the Internet; and (b) not increase (i) manufacturers or distributors recorded in subsection (a), (b), (d) or (e) of the 823 section of this title that do not dispensing controlled substances for a non-registered or entity; (II) nonpharmacy practitioners that are recorded under section 823 (f) of this title and whose activities are admitted by that registration; (iii) any hospital or other medical center, which is operated by a United States agency (including armed forces), provided that such a hospital or another installation is registered under the 823 (f) of this title; (iv) a property unit of property or operated by an indigenous tribe or tribal organization, only in that facility is the realization of a contract or compact under indigenous self-determination and Education Assistance Act [25 USC 5301 and following]; (V) any agent or employment of any hospital or center referred to in Clausula (III) or (IV), provided that this agent or employee is legally acting in the normal course of business or employment, and of its official functions of such an agent or employee, with such hospital or center, and with regard to agents or health center employees specified in item (iv), the services only in the measured in such individuals are furniture according to contracts or pacts in this type clause; (Vi) mere advertisements that do not attempt to facilitate a real transaction involving a controlled substance; (Vii) a person, entity or internet internet site It is not in the United States and does not facilitate delivery, distribution or distribution of a controlled substance through the Internet for anyone in the United States; (viii) a pharmacy recorded in terms of section 823 (f) of the present title, whose distribution of controlled substances through the Internet consists only of       " (i) recharging prescribes for substances controlled in Program III, IV, as defined in paragraph (55); or (ii) to fulfill new prescriptions for substances controlled in the III program, IV, or V, as defined in paragraph (56); or (IX) any other persons for whom the Prosecutor General and the Secretary are jointly, by the Regulation, considered consistent with effective controls against deviation and otherwise consistent with the public health health and safety to exempt from the definition of a "online pharmacia. (53) The term "homepage" means the opening or main page or screen from the site of an online pharmacy that is visible on the Internet. (54) The term "telemedicine practice" means for purposes of this subcapture, the practice of medicine according to the applicable federal and state laws      

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
